A cumulative work experience of minimum one year in a reputed State or Central Government Institute/ Research centre (Duration spent as part of any academic programme, including any degree/diploma, will not be considered as work experience. Ph.D degree holders and post graduates in Veterinary Science are exempted. Ph.D students awaiting final viva-voce should produce proof of submission of thesis).

4. Hands on experience in techniques such as PCR, Real Time PCR, ELISA and other diagnostic /molecular biology techniques.
