LIMITED TENDER NOTICE

Sealed limited tenders are invited for the **Department of Veterinary Clinical Medicine, Ethics and Jurisprudence, CVAS, Pookode** on behalf of The Dean, College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, KVASU, Pookode from reputed registered firms/manufacturers/authorized dealers for the **Supply of an Oscillometric Blood Pressure Apparatus (Veterinary)**, to the Department of Veterinary Clinical Medicine, Ethics and Jurisprudence as detailed in **Annexure 1**, under the State Plan Project of the station 2022-23 of the Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University.

All the rules/ regulations applicable to Government limited tenders will be applicable here also.

Last date for the receipt of Limited Tender is **22.12.2022 at 2.00 P.M and will be opened at 3.00P.M. the same day** in the presence of bidders or their authorized representatives. EMD and Agreement in Kerala stamp paper as detailed below should be furnished along with the Limited Tender. Further details if any, can be had from the Office of the undersigned during working hours.

The envelope containing the tenders should bear the superscription "**Limited tender for Oscillometric Blood Pressure Apparatus (Veterinary)- Department of Veterinary Clinical Medicine, Ethics and Jurisprudence, CVAS, Pookode**" and should be addressed to and sent to the following address:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Each tender should be accompanied by an **EMD of 2.5%** of the total quoted amount in the form of Demand Draft in favour of the **Dean, College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Pookode, Wayanad - 673 576** payable at the State Bank of India (SBI), Kalpetta. The tender should also be accompanied by an agreement in Kerala stamp paper worth Rs.200/- as per format appended. Late and incomplete tenders and tenders without EMD and agreement in Kerala stamp paper will not be accepted.
2. Firms who are exempted from payment of EMD should either be registered as Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) or with Store Purchase Department and furnish attested copy of the currently valid certificate/order from the Store Purchase Department, Government of Kerala or Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises, Government of India.

3. Successful bidder on confirmation of the tender will have to furnish a **Performance Security of 10 %** of the total cost of the equipment and execute an agreement in Kerala Stamp paper worth Rs.200/-. Performance Security in the form of Bank Guarantee drawn in favour of the **Dean, College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Pookode, Wayanad - 673 576 State Bank of India (S.B.I), Kalpetta (IFSC Code: SBIN0070192)** is to be furnished.
4. The rates quoted should be in Indian currency.
5. We are exempted from the payment of customs and excise duty for our procurements and hence prices quoted should be exclusive of these. The prices quoted should be inclusive of all taxes (GST), duties, cess, etc., which are or may become payable by the contractor under existing or future laws or rules of the country of origin/supply or delivery during the course of execution of the contract. The rate quoted must also include the transportation and installation charges. The tenders should clearly indicate the net cost of the machine and taxes/levies separately.
6. Details of warranty and after sale service offered after the expiry of warranty should be clearly stated in the tender.
7. The exact specification details of make, model, name of manufacturer etc., of the equipment offered must be clearly specified. Copies of detailed technical literature and illustrated brochures of equipment tendered are to be furnished along with the offer. The operating manuals are to be supplied along with the equipment.
8. Withdrawal of tenders after its acceptance or failure to supply the equipment during the specified period or not according to the specifications will entail cancellation of the tender and purchase will be affected from elsewhere at the expense of the contractor. The successful bidder should supply the items at Pookode campus, Wayanad within fortnight from the date of supply order. Otherwise, the items will be purchased locally or elsewhere and any loss incurred thereby will be payable by the defaulter. In such events, the University reserves the right to remove the defaulters name from the list of Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University suppliers permanently or for a specified period.
9. The article should be of good quality, properly packed and in conformity with the item quoted in the tender. If the article is found to be inferior quality or not in conformity to the specification as per tender will be summarily rejected and the supplier will have to take back the material at his cost within 15 days of intimation.
10. In case when the successful tenderers having made partial supplies fail to fulfill the contract in full, all or any of the material not supplied will be purchased by means of tender quotation or negotiation or from the next lowest tenders who had offered to supply already and the loss if any, caused to the University together with such sum as may be fixed by the University towards the damages shall be recovered from the defaulting tenderers.
11. Late tenders and tenders without EMD and agreement will be summarily rejected. All rules pertaining to Government of Kerala and India. Tenders will be applicable to this tender also.

12. The leaflets /brochures/ catalogues pertaining to the equipment describing its features, applications and specifications should be sent along with the tender.

13. The Dean, College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Pookode, Wayanad reserves the right to reject any tender without assigning any reason thereof.

Note: 1. The company should not have been black listed by any Government organization.
2. Validity of the limited tender should be for atleast three months.
