
ABSTRACTS

The papers must be based on the original work of the authors and must not have been published else where. Abstracts not exceeding 250 words (Times New Roman, fontsize-12) single spaced, in editable Microsoft word format (2007 Version) adhering to the guidelines of standard journals are required to be submitted by uploading to the website of the conference www.isvm2024.in Name of the author who is to present the paper and the scientific session to which the paper belongs, should be indicated in the abstract (underline the name). The papers shall be accepted only if the person presenting the paper/poster, register for the ISVM conference 2024 before 31 st December 2023. Due to scarcity of time, each participant will be allotted only one oral presentation. The size of poster shall be 150 cm (Length) and 90 cm (Width) (Without Border) use biodegradable material for poster. Now, it is part of Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University formed on trifurcation of erstwhile KAU in to veterinary and fisheries universities.

Thrissur, also known as the "cultural capital of Kerala, lies in central Kerala and is well-known for its cultural, religious, and historical significance. Thrissur originates from Malayalam word Thrissiva perur which means town of "sacred Siva", signified by the famous Vadakkumnathan temple, dedicated to lord Shiva and declared as a national monument. The temple hosts the annual Thrissur Pooram. The city houses the Bible Tower, Asia's tallest church tower with a mural painting commemorating Jesus Christ's life. The temple city of Guruvayur, the Dwaraka of south, is also located near the city (21 Km). Punnathurkotta, which serves as elephant training centre, is at Guruvayur. The Cheraman Juma Mosque located at Kodungallur, Thrissur is the oldest mosque in the Indian subcontinent which is still in use

Athirappilly waterfalls, described as Niagra of South India, is the largest waterfall in Kerala and is located around 50 km from the city. Thrissur district is bestowed with beautiful beaches and picturesque landscapes and dams.

HOW TO REACH THE VENUE
